Message from the Vicar

Beloved St. James Family members

Greetings in the name of Lord who redeemed us by the blood of Calvary. The early days of April mark the culmination of the Great Lent period. May our presence and participation in the various services of these days will make our spiritual life more meaningful. It is a time to enable us to accept Jesus Christ as King and Messiah. It is a time that gives us hope that after any suffering, after any brokenness, there is a resurrection. Christ's incarnation, crucifixion, and resurrection call us not to retreat in defeat and fear amid all the problems we face as human beings, but to draw new energy and courage directly from these experiences.

The word 'marathon' has ancient legendary roots: it comes from a long journey taken on foot by the Greek messenger Pheidippides, from the battlefields of Marathon to Athens in 490 BCE. The battle was the culmination of the first attempt by Persia, under King Darius I, to subjugate Greece. The Greek army inflicted a crushing defeat on the more numerous Persians, marking a turning point in the Greco-Persian Wars. It is said that Pheidippides ran approximately 25 miles(40km) without stopping and announced to the citizens of Athens, "We have won," before collapsing and dying. The Marathon race based on this story was first introduced at the Olympic Games in 1896.

Some two thousand years before, two women also ran to deliver good news- the most pivotal news in all of history. When Mary and Mary Magdalene arrived at the tomb where Jesus had been placed after His crucifixion, they found it empty. An angel told them that Jesus had "risen from the dead" and to "go quickly and tell his disciples" (Mt 28:7). The women, "afraid yet filled with joy," ran to tell the disciples what they had discovered (v.8). For a believer Easter meant the hope beyond the grave. But the real proof of the resurrection today is not the empty tomb or the post- resurrection appearances, but our living testimony as Christ's followers. May God strengthen us to bear witness to the resurrection.
