#### Beloved St. James Family Members

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We are now in the post-resurrection period. A common expression among some Christians is that we are living in the 'age of grace' or sometimes called the 'dispensation of grace'. "Even when we dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ- by the grace you have been saved-" (Ephe. 2:5). According to Dallas Willard, grace is "God doing in us and for us what we could not do ourselves."

Many Preachers and several authors have tried to define grace. Some said that grace is the unmerited favor of God. Grace is a divine election at the edge of human rejection. Salvation is possible in our lives only by God's grace. Salvation means that not only am I forgiven by grace, but I am also learning to live by grace. The apostle Paul was one whom God prepared to be satisfied with such grace. "My grace is sufficient for you" (2 Corin. 12:9). But many of us fail to understand the cost and glory of the grace available through Christ.

A man who was fishing one day noticed that the fisherman next to him threw the big fish he caught back into the water while keeping the small ones. This went on all day until the first man could not hold his curiosity any longer. "I don't understand," he asked the other fisherman. "Why do you keep throwing the big fish back and keeping only the small ones?" "It's simple," the other man answered. "My frying pan is too small to cook the big ones." A lot of Christians are like that fisherman... Their understanding of and response to God's grace are too limited, so their growth in grace is stunted.

Dietrich Bonhoeffer describes cheap grace versus costly grace in a variety of ways. Cheap grace means grace sold on the market... Cheap grace means grace as a doctrine, a principle, or a system.... Cheap grace means the justification of sin without the justification of the sinner.... Cheap grace is the preaching of forgiveness without requiring repentance, baptism without church discipline....

Costly grace is the treasure hidden in the field... Costly grace is the gospel that must be sought again and again, the gift which must be asked for, the door which a man must knock. Such grace is costly because it calls us to follow, and it is grace because it calls us to follow Jesus Christ. It is costly because it costs a man his life, and it is grace because it gives a man the only true life. It is costly. After all, it condemns sin, and grace because it justifies the sinner. Above all, it is costly because it cost God the life of his Son.... Above all it is grace because God did not reckon his Son too dear a price to pay for our life, but delivered him up for us. Costly grace is the Incarnation of God. May God grant us the grace to live as keepers and sharers of the grace made available to us all through Jesus Christ.
